- Retain and invigorate the working rural character of Lopez Island through ethical practices that build soil.



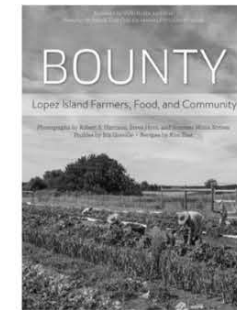
